

Pioneer Trails Regional Planning Commission

**Transportation Advisory Council (TAC)
Meeting Summary**

November 18, 2010 Regular Meeting

I. Call to Order

The regular bi-monthly meeting of the Pioneer Trails Regional Planning Commission (PTRPC) Transportation Advisory Council (TAC) was called to order on November 18, 2010 at 6:12 p.m. at the Concordia Community Center in Room 102 at 802 S. Gordon, Concordia, Missouri with Chair Clifford Jarvis presiding.
