III. Confirmation of Member Disqualification and Removal*

a. Removal of Riley Cameron as Pettis County Representative*

Per Article 3 section 6, Pettis County Commission requested the removal of Riley Cameron. Mr. Cameron has not attended a Pioneer Trails Regional Planning Commission TAC meeting since October 2021 qualifying for automatic resignation.

****Mr. Tom Charette motioned to approve the removal of Riley Cameron as a Pettis County representative. The motion was seconded by Mr. John Marr, and carried unanimously by an affirmative vote.****

b. Appointment of Bill Taylor (Pettis County Representative)

The Pettis County Commission provided a letter of appointment of Mr. Bill Taylor to serve the remaining term of Mr. Cameron. Letter of appointment was provided to the RPC and all TAC members prior to the regularly scheduled meeting.

IV. Consideration of April 20, 2023 meeting minutes*

Meeting minutes were provided via email to all members prior to the meeting. No additional comments or discussion took place.

VI. Missouri Department of Transportation

- MoDOT BRO Program applications will be reviewed July 27, 2023. Award announcement is expected August 4th.
- Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) call for projects is open until August 24th. Award announcement is expected November 1st.
- No Area Engineer has been hired for the PTRPC Region.

VII. TAC County Reports

Johnson Co.

- Hwy 50 and Division Road – Sign Blown over
- Warrensburg has hired a design consultant for the McGuire St. bridge. Has invited MoDOT to participate in project.
- Multiple concerns regarding planned crossover work along US 50 through Johnson County. Concerns have been conveyed to MoDOT from the Commission and during the public forum event. Concerns include but are not limited to the crossovers at Fairgrounds Rd, NW 251 Rd. It is believed current designs will effect business traffic and safety. Discussion is requested with County Commission regarding plans.
- Proposed changes to traffic flow concerns expressed on Hwy 50 and Young Street Bridge.

Lafayette Co.

- Rte. AA, South of the City of Corder (approximately 2 miles) at the Rte. V junction loose gravel consistently on roadway.

- Concerns were expressed regarding the necessity of chip seal projects along I70 outer roads.

Pettis Co.

- South bound Hwy 65 over Turkey creek – inside lane pavement failing
- Intersection of Rte. B and 32nd street – Traffic light timing limiting local traffic from crossing over US 65.
- Concerns reiterated US 65 and Rebar Road intersection.
- Main and US 65 near Oak Grove lane – additional rock is needed on the shoulder
- Rte. FF and Sunnydale Road – Radius widening requested

Saline Co.

- Rte. C from Slater to Miami- Maintenance concerns expressed

VIII. Other Business

- Transportation Needs Scoring sheets will be distributed August 1st to all TAC members. Score sheets will be due September 15th. Scoring instructions will be sent with sheets.
- City of Sedalia was awarded \$200,000 to develop an action plan with FY 2022 funding
- City of Warrensburg has applied for the SS4A program for action plan development in the current program call (Closed 7/10/23)
- City of Sedalia has applied for the SS4A program for implementation in the current program call (Closed 7/10/23)
- Pettis County has applied for the SS4A program for implementation in the current program call (Closed 7/10/23)
